Turkey's low cost of living and high purchasing power, as reflected by indicators like the Big Mac Index, make it an attractive destination for international students. The country offers both affordable living and quality education, giving students economic advantages over studying in more developed nations.

One of the main reasons for the low cost of living is the high purchasing power of the dollar in Turkey. Turkey has a low price level due to the impact of the exchange rate, which significantly reduces international students' basic expenses such as rent, transport and food.

Turkey offers a more affordable cost of living, where students can maintain a comfortable lifestyle for USD 300-500 per month. This makes Turkey an attractive option for international students seeking quality education at a lower cost compared to many other countries.

According to the latest **OECD data**, Türkiye's homicide rate is 1, lower than the OECD average of 2.6.

Work Permit in Turkey for International Students



Undergraduate students can obtain a work permit after the first year, provided that they do not exceed 24 hours per week. There is no restriction for postgraduate students. Students who wish to obtain a work permit must apply to the Ministry of Labour and Social Security.

What Documents Do I Need to Apply for an Associate/Bachelor?

Students wishing to apply for Associate or Undergraduate programmes must submit their

- Passport
- Photograph



Application Process



PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES







Step 1

Prepare your application documents as recommended and upload them to the our <u>web page</u>. You can track your application result <u>here</u>.



Step 2

We will review your documents, if there are no problems, we will start your application process and issue you a Conditional Acceptance Letter as soon as possible.



Step 3

After you receive the Conditional Acceptance Letter, you are required to make the deposit payment specified in the Conditional Acceptance Letter to the **bank account of university** specified in the letter and send us a copy of the receipt.



Step 4

We will send you your Final Acceptance Letter as soon as possible. The Final Acceptance Letter is required to obtain a student visa.



Step 5

You can come with the original documents, their certified Turkish translations and your Final Acceptance Letter and register on the dates specified by your university.

Step 6

After completing your registration, please make sure to send us a copy of your student certificate.




Deposit payments will be deducted from the annual payment to be made. Most universities refund the deposit to a certain extent if the visa is not obtained and this can be proved.

Application Process



PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES







Step 1

Prepare your application documents as recommended and upload them to the our <u>web page</u>. You can track your application result <u>here</u>.



Step 2

We will review your documents, if there are no problems, we will start your application process. In order for us to start your application process, you must have paid **half of the consultancy fee**.



Step 3

You can make your payment by bank transfer, credit card, western union (etc.) and cryptocurrency.



Step 4

The admission process of Public Universities depends on a certain calendar. **The dates of each university's acceptance letter varies.** We will clearly inform you of all dates when making an agreement with you.



Step 5

Once we receive the payment, we will send your Final Acceptance Letter immediately. The Final Acceptance Letter is required to obtain a student visa.



Step 6

You can come with the original documents, their certified Turkish translations and your Final Acceptance Letter and register on the dates specified by your university.



The payment is non-refundable for students who are unable to attend due to visa issues or any other circumstances. If there is a problem caused by us, your full payment will be refunded to you.

Language Proficiency





Many universities in Turkey do not require Turkish or English language proficiency for admission. You can start your academic journey without worrying about language tests in advance.

Language Proficiency for University Registration Turkish Proficiency

- Yunus Emre Institute Turkish Proficiency Exam (TYS)
 C1 level is generally expected for Turkish proficiency. However, this may vary depending on the university.
- TÖMER (Turkish Language Centers)
 Each university has a Turkish Language Teaching Centre. Generally, B2 level is considered sufficient to start the programme you are accepted to. In departments such as Medicine and Dentistry, you must have a minimum C1 level proficiency certificate. Requirements vary from university to university. Always check with your chosen university.

No Need to Know Language Before Arrival!

English Proficiency

- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)

 Most universities require a score between 80 and 100 for international programs.
- YDS (Foreign Language Proficiency Exam)
 Conducted by ÖSYM, YDS is accepted for graduate studies and by some universities as a language proficiency exam.

TOEFL IBT, YDS (Foreign Language Proficiency Test), YÖKDİL (Higher Education Institutions Foreign Language Examination), PTE Academic (Pearson Test of English), CPE (Cambridge English: Proficiency) and CAE (Cambridge English: Advanced) are among the official language certificates accepted by students wishing to study in English at universities in Turkey.

While language courses at private universities usually cost full price, language courses at state universities are more affordable, with fees ranging from \$150 to \$250 per course.



At the beginning of the academic year, students take a language proficiency exam administered by the university. Students who pass the exam begin their academic programme immediately, while those who fail must attend language classes offered by the university.

Each university has a Turkish Language Teaching Centre. Generally, B2 level is considered sufficient to start the programme you are accepted to. In departments such as Medicine and Dentistry, you must have a minimum C1 level proficiency certificate.

Requirements vary from university to university. Always check with your chosen university.

Those who have completed their high school education in English or whose native language is English will be exempted from the preparatory class and exam if they present documents that can prove this.

A maximum of 2 years can be spent in the preparatory class; students who exceed this period will be dismissed from the school.

What is TR-YOS





It is a central examination organised for international students who wish to study at universities in Turkey. This exam is designed to assess the academic qualifications of foreign applicants seeking admission to many universities in Turkey. TR-YÖS was initiated by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) in 2023 and is a standardised exam for universities valid throughout Turkey.

Examination Content and Format

TR-YOS is an exam consisting of 80 questions that measure general ability and basic mathematical skills. In this exam, which lasts 100 minutes for each candidate, the mathematics and general aptitude questions test students' analytical thinking and problem-solving skills. The score of the exam is calculated using a coefficient of 0.55 for each maths question and 0.45 for each general ability question. Wrong answers in the exam can also affect the correct answers, so it is important to be careful.

Examination Fees and Results

TR-YOS examination fees vary depending on the university and examination centre chosen. There are different fees for domestic and foreign centres and these fees generally vary between 150 ₺ and 1200 ₺.

If you have a valid score from these exams, you can increase your chances of applying to and being accepted by prestigious universities in Turkey.

To study at a university in Turkey, you must apply for a student visa at the nearest Turkish embassy or consulate in your country. You must be in possession of a student visa before entering Turkey.

The only exceptions are students from the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, students whose parents are in Turkey on a work visa, and Blue Card holders.

When you attend your visa appointment at the consulate or embassy in Turkey, you will have a short interview with a consular officer. During this interview you will be asked a number of questions about the course you wish to study in Turkey, your educational plans and your reasons for travelling. This interview can determine whether or not your visa is approved, so it is important to make a good impression.



Students coming to Turkey from a visa-free country can come as tourists and complete the university registration and residence permit process within 90 days.

These students do not need to obtain a Student Visa.



When do you need to apply for a student visa in Turkey?

If you plan to study in Turkey for more than 6 months, you will need to apply for a student visa. You can apply for this visa up to 3 months before you travel to Turkey. As the visa process can take a long time, it is advisable to apply as soon as possible after receiving your acceptance letter.



How do I apply for a student visa to Turkey?

Students wishing to study in Turkey should contact the nearest Consulate of the Republic of Turkey to apply for a student visa. As the visa application process can take some time, it is important to apply as soon as you receive your acceptance letter. To find out how the visa process works and the visa requirements for your country, please visit the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey.



Attending your visa appointment

You must go to the consulate to apply for a visa. On the day of your appointment, there will be a short interview at the consulate and you may be asked questions about your plans to study in Turkey. You should try to make a positive impression at this interview as this can be crucial in getting your visa approved. You should also make sure that you bring all the necessary documents with you. Missing even one document could result in your application being rejected.



By following these steps, you can ensure that your Turkish student visa application goes smoothly.

Residence Permit





You are responsible for all legal matters relating to your residence permit. Please take the necessary steps to avoid any legal problems with your residence permit. This guide has been prepared to assist you.

Initial Application

International students who are new to the university should start the residence application process as soon as possible. After completing the online application, you must go to the Provincial Immigration Office on the date you are given.





What is an International Office at a University?





International Offices at universities offer a comprehensive range of services to international students. These services start with the enrolment process and continue through to the completion of your studies.

- O1 International Offices provide guidance to international students on the application and admission process. This process provides detailed support at every stage, from document preparation to application.
- Provides advice on visas and residence permits required for foreign students to study in Turkey. It assists students in completing the application forms, collecting the necessary documents and following up on the application.
- International Offices organise orientation programmes to help new international students adjust to Turkey and the university. These programmes help students to adjust quickly to campus and city life.
- Academic counsellors advise students on their choice of courses, monitor their academic performance and provide academic support when needed. They also help students to deal with any difficulties they may encounter during their studies.
- O5 International Offices offer opportunities such as cultural trips, social events and student clubs to help foreign students get to know Turkish culture. These activities allow students from different cultures to mix with each other.
- O6 International Offices help students to find safe and suitable accommodation on or off campus. They also provide advice on a range of issues that students may encounter in their daily lives.

Fees and Scholarships

Tuition Fees

Tuition fees are paid directly to the relevant university. Universities in Turkey accept payment by international bank transfer, credit card or debit card. Fees vary according to the university and programme. In programmes such as Medicine and Dentistry, tuition fees can be paid in instalments.

Discounted Price

There is a difference between the prices you pay when you apply individually and the prices you benefit from when you apply through us. Public Transport Options

Public transport in Turkey is well developed in major cities. You can easily get around the city by metro, tram, bus, metrobus and minibus. Sea transport also plays an important role in cities such as Istanbul; you can travel between the Asian and European continents by ferry. For intercity travel, high-speed train projects, modern bus terminals and nearly 60 airports across the country make it easy to get where you want to go.

Seasons in Turkey

Turkey has a diverse climate with different geographical regions, with varying rainfall and seasonal conditions throughout the year. This diversity makes Turkey attractive to international students, both academically and as a natural experience.

Black Sea Region

Located in the north of Turkey, the Black Sea coast is a region that receives abundant rainfall throughout the year. The average annual rainfall varies between 1000-2500 mm. The Black Sea climate is characterised by heavy rainfall, especially in autumn and winter, which preserves green forests and rich vegetation.


Marmara Region

The Marmara Region, which includes Istanbul and the surrounding area, has a temperate climate. The average annual rainfall is between 500-1000 mm and the rainfall is intense, especially in autumn and winter. While summers are hot and dry, the winter months are cooler and rainy.

Aegean and Mediterranean Regions

These regions have a Mediterranean climate, with hot, dry summers and mild, rainy winters. The Aegean and Mediterranean coasts receive between 600-1000 mm of rainfall annually. Rainfall tends to be concentrated in the winter and spring months, with very little rainfall in the summer.

Although the average annual temperature varies from region to region, Turkey has a generally temperate climate. The average annual temperature throughout the country is around 15-21°C.



Intertwined with History and Nature

Turkey is a country rich in history and culture. During your time as a student, you will have many opportunities to explore the fascinating landscapes of **Cappadocia**, walk on the travertine in Pamukkale or visit iconic buildings such as the Hagia Sophia and Topkapi Palace in Istanbul. 






A Safe and Modern Life

Turkey offers a safe and peaceful living environment for international students. University campuses in major cities provide students with safe and modern facilities. The advanced healthcare system is easily accessible to international students, with services available in both public and private hospitals. In addition, Turkey offers various scholarships, accommodation and social facilities for students to make your educational life more comfortable.







Health Insurance





If foreign students studying in Turkey apply to the Provincial Directorate of Social Security with a student certificate and a request within three months from the date of first enrolment, they will be covered by general health insurance for one year from the day following the date of application.

Private Health Insurance

Ordinary health insurance covers basic medical services but does not make large deductibles for treatment. Accident, medical and analysis insurance covers the cost of examinations, tests and accidents in hospital. Comprehensive insurance covers all treatment, surgery and accident costs, but is the most expensive option.

General Health Insurance

Under Turkish law, foreigners with certain residence permits can benefit from public health insurance, which provides free medical services in public hospitals, except for children over the age of 18.

Best Option for the Health Insurance

International students studying in Turkey are required to have valid health insurance. It is important that you renew your insurance when it expires, otherwise you may face legal and health problems. Students can be covered by public health insurance (GHI) or private health insurance. For the GHI, it is necessary to apply to the Provincial Directorate of Social Security and take action within the legal period of 3 months. In addition, students who have valid insurance in Turkey through their parents are obliged to document this situation to the Migration Directorate.

SIM Card for International Students





Communication is very important for students coming to Turkey to study. In this context, ready-made SIM cards that they can use from the moment they arrive in Turkey are a great convenience. This way, students can stay in touch from the moment they set foot in Turkey.

SIM Card Activation Process

There are only three GSM providers in Turkey that can set you up with a SIM card and data plan. Turkcell, Vodafone, and Turk Telekom are the three operators and all mostly have a good coverage and speed in Turkey.

At Turkcell, the best of these, we will prepare your e-sim card for you before you arrive, so you can enjoy the convenience of using a local line when you arrive in Turkey.

Device Registration for Foreign Identification Number (FIN) Holders

Devices brought to Turkey from abroad can be used for 6 months without registration. After that, your device will be closed to the data line. You can continue to use your device via Wi-Fi.

Foreign nationals who have reached the age of 18 and have a Foreigner Identity Number (YN) can register their devices through the 'e-Government' system. For this process, the 'e-Government' password obtained from PTT is used. Foreigners with FIN can perform their registration procedures through the 'e-Government' system.

Opening a Bank Account





The process of opening a bank account for international students in Turkey is fairly straightforward and various banks offer facilities for students. You can apply at any of the bank's branches. Below is a general guide to the process and documents required;

Required Documents

The following documents are generally required for international students to open a bank account:

- Passport: Valid passport and a photocopy.
- **Student Certificate:** An official document proving that you are a student in Turkey (student acceptance letter or university registration document).
- Foreign Identity Number (YKN): Students must obtain a Foreign Identity Number (YKN) during their stay in Turkey. This number is required to open a bank account.
- Residence Permit: Your residence permit document in Turkey or proof of your application.
- **Tax Number:** You must have a tax number to open a bank account in Turkey. This tax number can be obtained from the tax office or by some banks.
- **Residence Address:** A utility bill or residence document may be required for address declaration.

Application Process

Application: You apply by going to the bank branch of your choice with your documents.

Account Opening: After the bank officials review your documents and complete the process, your account will be opened. This process usually takes **1-2 business days.**

You can access internet banking with the card provided by your bank and easily perform your transactions online.
